What are the specific details?

Duration	You have up to eight weeks to complete the course.
Venue	Run via distance learning and can therefore be fitted around work and personal life.
Cost	Free (fully government funded)*.

Who is this course suitable for?

Learners are required to undertake the following units:

- Unit 1 Principles of the causes and spread of infection in health care settings
- Unit 2 Principles of the importance of personal hygiene and health in the prevention and control of infection
- Unit 3 Principles of decontamination, cleaning, and waste management in health care settings
- Unit 4 Principles of infection prevention and control in health care settings

*Learners must be 19 years+ and have lived in the UK/EU for 3 years.
