

# Should I send my little one to school?

Would you have kept them at home before COVID-19?

Yes

**Keep your little one at home.**

Check for signs of COVID-19.  
They do NOT need a COVID test.

If you would normally seek medical advice, continue to do so.

**If your little one gets better**

They can go back to school for some super-fun times!

**Keep your little one at home**

Contact 119 or visit [www.gov.uk/coronavirus](http://www.gov.uk/coronavirus) to arrange a COVID-19 test.

Inform your school.

Your little one and everyone in the household must self-isolate until you have the results of the test.

If your little one becomes unwell, contact NHS 111, your GP or out-of-hours services.

**Do they have at least one of the following?**

1. A NEW continuous cough?
2. A fever (over 37.8°C on a thermometer)
3. Loss or change in sense of smell?

No

**If your little one is otherwise well with a mild illness...**

they can go to school as normal and play with their friends!

Yes

**If the test is POSITIVE or you were unable to arrange a test...**

Your little one must stay home for at least 10 days from the onset of symptoms.

**If the test is NEGATIVE and the temperature has gone for 24 hours...**

Your little one can go back to school for some top notch learning!
